INTRODUCTION

The Boeing 727 short-to-medium range trijet is the world's most second most successful jetliner and an important part of the Boeing success story.

THE PACKAGE

This package will install a Deer Valley Flying Club paint job onto Mike Stone's Boeing 727-200 model for Microsoft Flight Simulator 9. This package contains a whole aircraft model, including Ken Mitchell's Boeing 727-200 panel. Although there is no need to download anything else other than this file for a 727, you may find other great planes at Mike Stone's website:

INSTALLATION

1. Installation could not be easier. Just unzip the entire package into your Microsoft Flight Simulator 9 main directory. By default this is located:

C:\Program Files\Microsoft Games\Flight Simulator 9

but your setup may be different. **Important: Make sure you check the “Use” Folder Names” option.**

2. Alternatively you may unzip the files into a temporary directory and move them to the appropriate place yourself.

3. Whichever method you use, afterwards; you should find a Deer Valley Flying Club model listed under Boeing 727-200 in your flight simulator.

LEGAL

Mike Stone created the original Boeing 727-200 used in this package. Ken Mitchell developed the panel used. The Deer Valley Flying Club textures were repainted by me, Cap'n Dave. The repaint package is released as freeware with the permission of all involved. Mike Stone retains all property rights for the model and the texture files. DO NOT redistribute without his permission.

The contents of this package should not cause any harm to your computer. However, you use them at your own risk.
